

N+erials

- Discussion Read Aloud
- Read Aloud Cards
- Activity Cards
- White paper
 - Markers
- Foam shapes
- Optional: cardboard
- Optional: cookie cutters

Objec+ives

- Child will be able to explain what a shape is
- Child will be able to create their own shape artwork

Introduce/Review

• With a piece of paper and a pencil, have your child draw and color as many shapes as they can think of.

Teach

- Read/discuss the Discussion Read Aloud.
- Optional: Watch <u>this video</u>. Your child may want a piece of paper to draw along with the video.

Review/Extend

• Discuss the project(s) you made.

Overlapping Shape Art





Before the lesson: Print out Activity Card s I-4 on cardstock and cut them out (cutting the inside of the shape out as well). This will create a stencil. Cookie cutters would also be wonderful for this activity. Younger children may only need the large shapes.

- Select one shape and trace it onto the white paper with a black marker.
- Chose several more shapes and trace them (overlapping is okay and encouraged).
- · Color in some of the interior spaces.

Foam Shape Collage

You will need foam shapes from a craft supply store.

- Choose Activity Card 5-8 and print onto paper or cardstock OR create a large shape out of cardboard.
- Glue the foam shapes inside the large shape.

Using foam shapes, make a picture!

You could also make a picture and use one shape to be something (like a circle could be a soccer ball).

We've been learning all about line the past few weeks. But what happens when you draw a line and connect both ends together? You've made a shape!

What shapes can you name? (allow time for a response)

One at a time show the shapes from Read Aloud Card I. Discuss each shape noticing the straight and curved lines that make each one.

Do you remember how we learned that colors can make you feel different ways. Well, shapes can make you think about different things too!

Look at all of these shapes *again* (show the shapes from Read Aloud Card I). Which shapes makes you think of something moving? Allow time for a response. I hope you said a circle!


When I see a circle I immediately think of balls or wheels, don't you?


(Show a rectangle)


What do you think of when you see a rectangle? (*allow for a response*) Probably something that stays still. A refrigerator. A box. Maybe even a cracker.


Artists pay a lot of attention to shapes just like they do lines. In the coming weeks we'll look at some specific paintings where shape is very important.


A triangle probably reminds you of something sharp or may a rocket that flies.




















