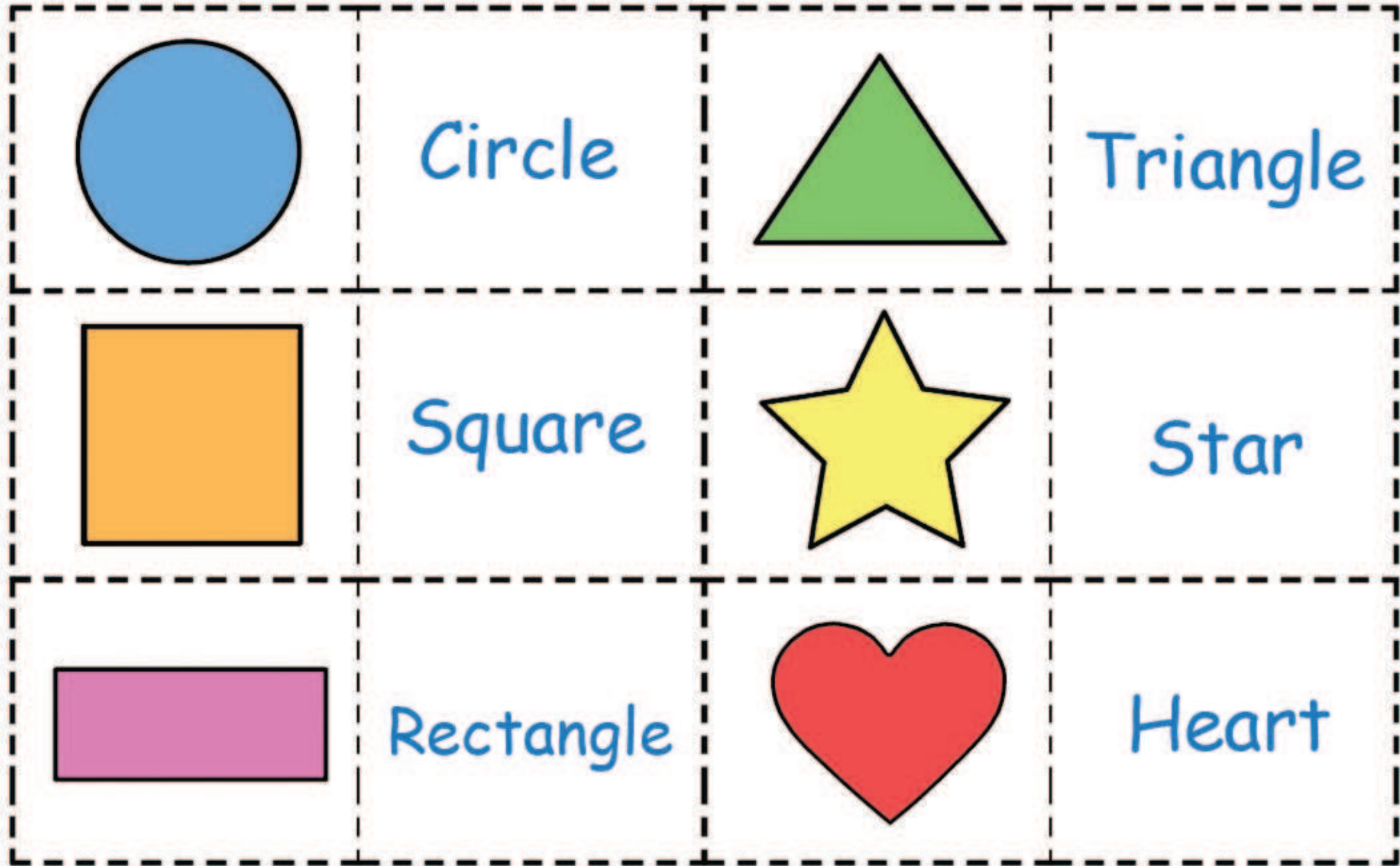
MAKE A MATCH: MUSIC

6. The player with the most matches in the end, wins!

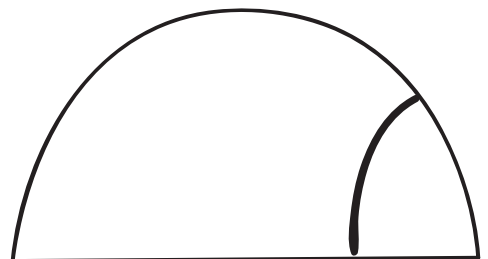
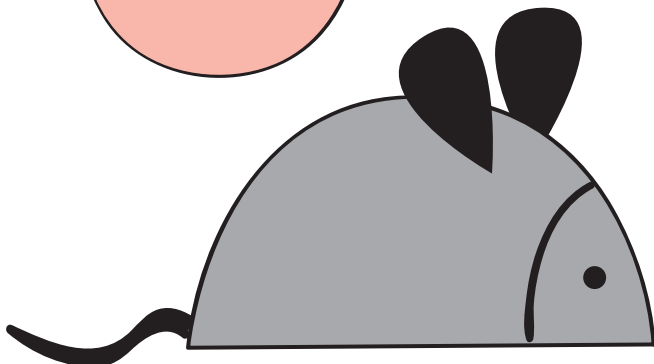
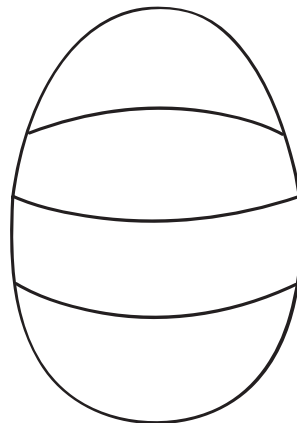
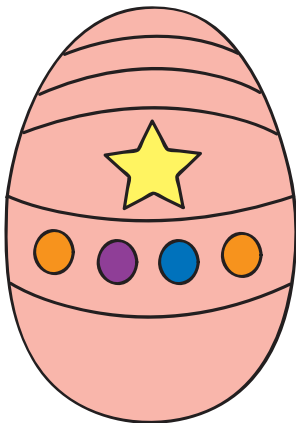
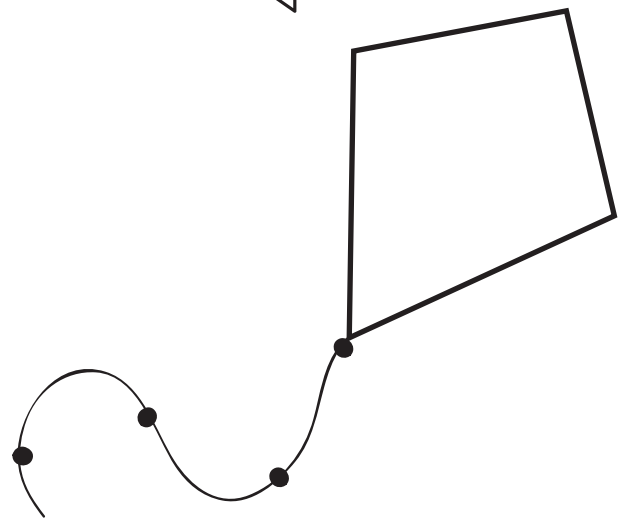
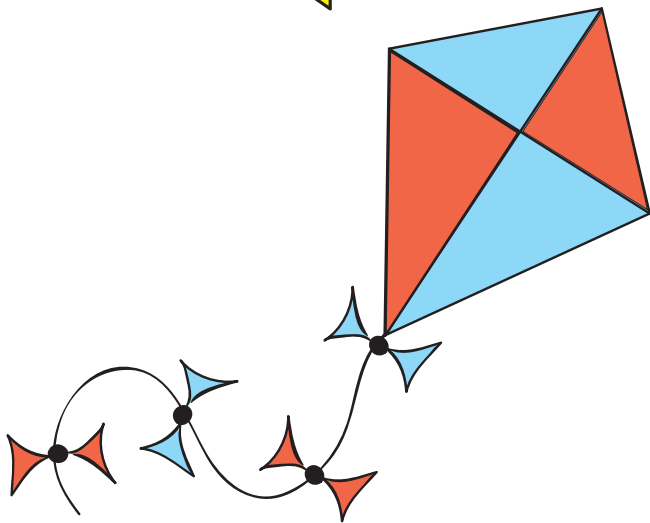
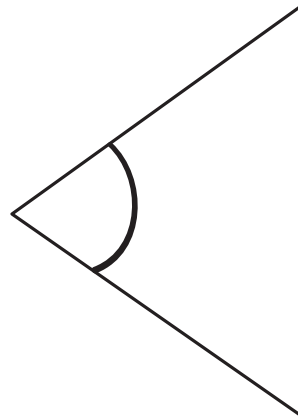
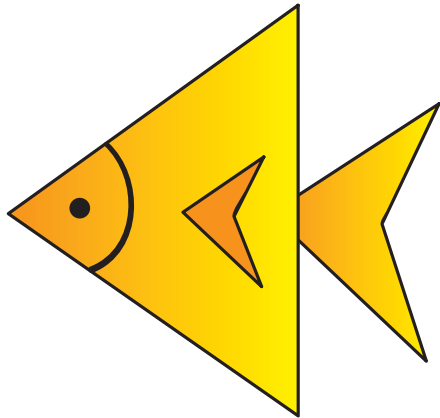
